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
Context

Objectives

The main objective is **to strengthen the capacity of vocational education and training centers** in Tunisia, Morocco, and Libya **to foster entrepreneurial spirit** among both educators and learners, utilizing **innovative pedagogical methods and digital resources** to enhance employability and entrepreneurial skills within the region.



Specific objectives

- 1** Enhance entrepreneurial capacities of VET Educators through targeted **Capacity Building**.
- 2** Upgrade the quality of **VET Curricula** by introducing new tools, materials, and feedback mechanisms.
- 3** Establish **Innovation Rooms (SMARTLABS)** within VET Centers to foster and promote entrepreneurship.
- 4** Establish a transnational **Network** to facilitate **collaboration and exchange of best practices**, facilitating cooperation between public and private sector to enrich VET Programmes.
- 5** Establish a **program within VET Centers** aimed at promoting an entrepreneurial spirit focusing on the development of soft-skills and upskilling trainers with innovative pedagogical methodologies and digital skills.
- 6** To upskill trainers with **innovative pedagogical methodologies** while integrating digital tools to create dynamic learning environments.
- 7** To facilitate **collaboration between public and private sectors**


